In accordance with Senate Bill No. 2241 of the Mississippi Legislature Regular Session 1981, the industry wide cost indexes of petroleum products, including asphalt, are furnished herein

The established indexes are for your use in calculating the change in price of a specific product month to month for those contracts which include escalation (price adjustments) clauses. The contracts which include escalation clauses should have in the proposal the indexes for the month the proposals are furnished to prospective bidders. Thereafter, the change in price from the original contract price (placed in the proposal) can be calculated each month and price adjustment made for applicable work accomplished during the current period.
